Southwestern Illinois Day at the Capitol: March 11, 2015 in Springfield





Powers was named West Region president in 2004, and in 2010 was promoted to group president of the West Region, with the added duties as CEO of Bremer's Twin Cities charter from 2010 to 2012. He most recently served as group president of Bremer's West Region prior to his selection as president and CEO of TheBANK of Edwardsville.
